BUILD IT UP

Goal: To help your child practice measuring by using the words shorter and taller

Overview: As young children learn how to build and stack blocks, they often love building towers as tall as possible! This is a great time to talk with children about the size of their towers and help them use math words like shorter and taller.

Materials: Blocks

Directions:

- 1. Ask your child to build block towers with you.
- 2. As your child is building, talk to your child about your towers using the words shorter and taller. You can say, "Your tower is taller than mine!" or "Can you build a tower that is shorter than mine?"
- 3. Encourage your child to knock the tower down and play again.
